



Looking Back with 20/20 Vision: 2007

In 2007, the Walk for Vision was held in New Jersey for the very first time—marking an exciting expansion of this powerful community event beyond Boston. The year before, OIUF had revived the Walk for Vision in Boston in 2006, establishing it as an official program fundraiser.

The roots of this event stretch back even further: in 2003 and 2004, Frances Foster and the Uveitis Support Group held the original Walk for Vision, uniting patients, families, and clinicians in early efforts to raise awareness and support. After a brief hiatus, their vision lived on through OIUF's renewed commitment to the cause.

Today, Walk for Vision remains a cornerstone of our mission—reminding us that when we walk together, we move closer to a world where no one faces ocular inflammatory disease alone.
